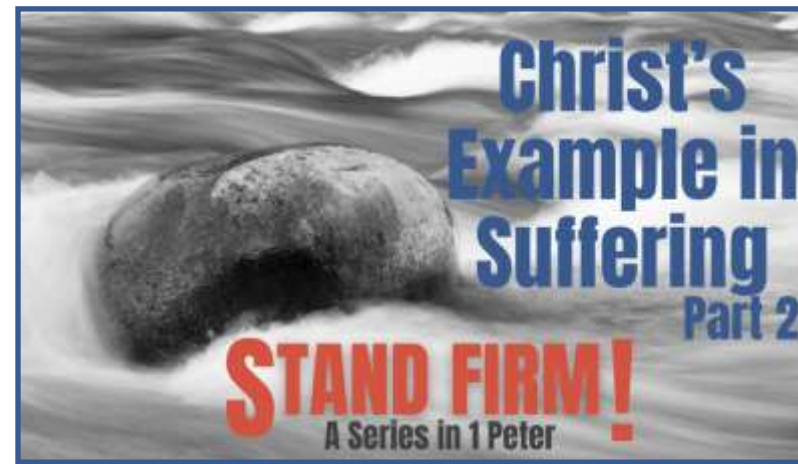

Being Christian is completely dependent on doing and being "in the Spirit" yet he is often overlooked or misunderstood. We are going to spend the next 8 weeks looking at what scripture says about the Spirit of God. We will ask questions as a group and work on methods on how to answer those questions from what is written in the Bible. Let us find out together what it means to be in the Spirit. This class will meet in the front Fellowship Hall on Sundays at 9am and is facilitated by Ben Zieske and Pastor Matt.



Our second Adult Sunday School class is **"The Heart of Family"**. "The Heart of Family" is designed to share the principles that Kirk and Chelsea Cameron have learned in nearly 30 years of marriage and parenting. They are solid, biblically-based, and faith-filled. This isn't a self-help seminar. This is about bringing the lessons God has taught them to you and growing you as a spouse and as a parent. It's an investment not just in your family but culture, as Heaven starts in the home and flows out from there. Class facilitators include Melissa Christiansen and Rachel Rambow and the class meets in the Youth Room, Sundays at 9am.
