


# Welcome

WE'RE SO GLAD YOU'RE HERE


Our nursery is available for children up to age 2. Seedlings (ages 3-5) will be dismissed during worship.

- If NL-S schools have canceled or sent students home early due to inclement weather, evening programs at ECC are automatically canceled or rescheduled. A school "late start" generally does not affect our church evening schedule.
- Cancellations or late start of any church-related activity will be posted on our website, [nlcovchurch.org](http://nlcovchurch.org), and on Willmar radio station KWLM's Operation Snowdesk (1340AM radio, or [willmarradio.com](http://willmarradio.com) and click on Operation Snowdesk).
- Weather-related Cancellations will also be sent out as an email to those on the church's mid-week update email list.
- Use your own discretion. If you deem it not safe to be out, stay at home, even if an event has not been canceled.

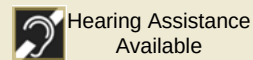

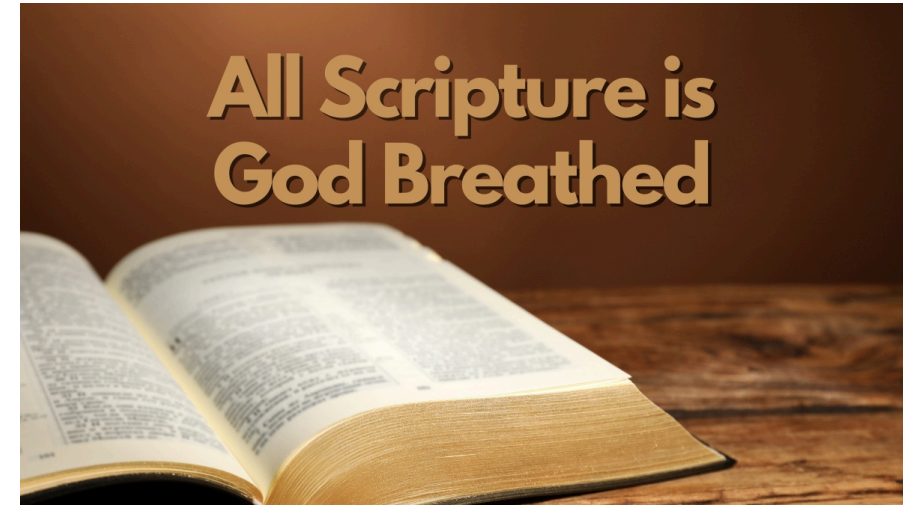
