

In fear and amazement they asked one another, "Who is this? He commands even the winds and the water, and they obey him."



Weather-Related Cancellation Policy

During these coming winter months, when you question whether an ECC event or activity has been canceled or rescheduled due to weather, please note the following guidelines:

- If NL-S schools have canceled or sent students home early due to inclement weather, evening programs at ECC are automatically canceled or rescheduled. A school "late start" generally does not affect our church evening schedule.
- Cancellations or late start of any church-related activity will be posted on our website, nlcovchurch.org, and on Willmar radio station KWLM's Operation Snowdesk (1340AM radio, or willmarradio.com and click on Operation Snowdesk).
- Weather-related Cancellations will also be sent out as an email to those on the church's mid-week update email list.
- Use your own discretion. If you deem it not safe to be out, stay at home, even if an event has not been canceled.

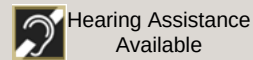
